

# **Data Dictionary for the Goucher Quarterly Collection**

The Goucher College Quarterly Collection will feature issues of the Goucher Quarterly, a publication generated by the college. The collection will feature born digital versions of the Quarterly as well as scanned versions of older, print copies.

Please note that there was a title change for this periodical:

From v.1-49 no.1 1921-Fall 1970: Goucher Alumnae Quarterly

From v.49 no.2 Winter 1941- : Goucher Quarterly

This document serves to explain the various metadata fields in CONTENTdm used to describe the various aspects of each item to allow for the consistent creation of metadata for items across the collection.

Each field is described by a table. An explanation of the table is below:

<b>Project Element</b>	The label for the metadata element.
<b>DC Mapping</b>	The Dublin Core metadata property is represented by this element.
<b>Data Type</b>	Either "Text" or "Date", per CONTENTdm.
<b>Required/Optional</b>	Must a description of a resource contain this property?
<b>Repeatable</b>	Can there be more than one field with this element name in the description of the resource?
<b>Display</b>	Will this element display to the public?
<b>Searchable</b>	Can patrons search on the data represented in this field?
<b>Controlled Vocabulary</b>	Are the values for this element constrained by any controlled vocabularies? If so, list them.
<b>Definition</b>	The definition of this element as established by the Dublin Core Metadata Initiative.
<b>Usage</b>	How this element is used in this Collection.
<b>Example</b>	An example taken from our extant Collection.

<b>Usage</b>	<p>The title will include the enumeration, date, and then title of the Quarterly. This will allow a rough chronological sorting of the collection simply by organizing the collection by title.</p> <p>[For when we change from linking out to pulling each issue in as a compound object: For <b>PAGE LEVEL metadata</b>, we will only have the titles. Use the same title as for the issue and then include the page number.]</p>

<b>Definition</b>	Transcript of PDF. Necessary for OCR Extension to work within ContentDM.
<b>Usage</b>	<p>This will be the full-text of each issue in this collection.</p> <p><b>[This field will not be used for the first uploading of this collection. Due to space constraints, we will be pointing outwards to a pdf of each issue. When we load the Quarterly as OCR'd compound objects, we will need to have this field.]</b></p>
<b>Example</b>	Will vary with each issue.

Only the year of digitization is expressed.</p> <p><b>All of the scanned issues will have the year 2013.</b></p> <p><b>All the “born digital” will be the same year as publication date (as the electronic version of the issue was created at the same time).</b></p>
